Seniors must have met the following requirements at the time of graduation to **qualify** for the A+ Schools Financial Assistance. Status reports (indicating GPA, attendance, citizenship and tutoring hours) are sent home each semester to all A+ students.

CHECKLIST

- Signed A+ Agreement form is on file in the A+ Office
- Attended BHS for 3 consecutive years prior to graduation
- Cumulative, un-weighted GPA is at or above 2.5
- Cumulative attendance is at or above 95%
- 50 hours of tutoring/mentoring has been completed

To access the two years assistance of tuition and fees to attend a Missouri community college or vocational/technical school, each eligible student must:

- Make a documented, good faith effort to secure all available federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require repayment (FAFSA).**

To meet the Federal Student Financial Aid deadline:

- Apply as early as possible beginning January 1st of each year.
- Schools and states have their own deadlines. Contact them for exact deadline dates.

- Male students at 18 years of age must register with the selective service**

The easiest and fastest way for a man to register is to [register on-line](#). Or a man can fill out a registration card and send it to the Selective Service System. The form asks for the young man's full name, address, date of birth, telephone number, and Social Security number (if he has one). On a form that is sent in, his signature is also required.
